Goal #1 Action Steps

Paraprofessionals will be hired to assess students' reading skills using the Acadience Reading Assessment. Students will be identified as well-below, below, benchmark, or above benchmark in grades K-6. Additional Diagnostic assessments will be given to students identified as well-below or below benchmark to identify specific needs for additional support. Paraprofessionals will be hired to provide targeted reading interventions for students below benchmark in grades K-6. (\$23,300). Teachers will meet weekly in collaborative teams to review standards/curriculum, develop common formative assessments, analyze data, modify instruction, and determine the placement of students for weekly interventions and enrichment activities facilitated by a combination of teachers and aides. This collaborative time will be created when students attend Computer, P.E., and Art/Music. (\$8,000)	\$31,300.00
The Kindergarten teachers will administer the District Kindergarten Assessment in August. The kindergarten assessment will provide reading data for the teachers to use at the beginning of the year. A stipend will be allocated to allow the teachers to administer the district assessment.	\$590.00

Teachers will be involved in professional development and student success meetings to support reading through colleague observations, vertical teaming, school and district training, online PD, and workshops or conferences. Substitutes or stipends will be provided for approved professional development or student success meetings offered.	\$2,000.00
Technology and hardware needs (ex. Chromebook Lease, Newline panel) will be provided to support reading instruction. (\$16,000)	\$16,000.00
The CLT will meet to refine the schoolwide vision, mission, goals, and commitments. Time will also be spent modifying the master schedule with a focus on meeting recommended time commitments to Tier 1, Tier 2, and Tier 3 instruction.	\$900.00

This will require student notebooks, professional development with teachers, student leadership supplies and materials to celebrate student success.	\$3,500.00
The software program, Panorama, will be used to help identify the needs of students. We will use the Panorama survey to inform us of where students see their needs in the areas of social and emotional health.	\$200.00
We are adding a Wellness/Zen Den de-escalation space this year that we will call the Eagle's Nest. Creating a space where students can go to de-escalate will support the student's social and emotional health and will reduce disruptions to student learning.	\$3,000
